On a daily basis the Olivet Boys & Girls Club provides educational, leadership, life skills and recreational programs to nearly 100 youth at the PAL Unit. Providing opportunities in a safe environment to the kids who need us the most after school is essential to keeping them off the streets, being empowered by positive role models and learning skills for their lifetime.

From September to June each year, the Olivet Boys & Girls Club hosts “Feed A Friend” at the PAL Unit to provide a nutritious meal to the children and youth of our community. Held every Thursday evening, from 5:00 PM until 6:00 PM, 100-200 kids enjoy a hot, nutritious meal for dinner. In addition, the kids have an opportunity to interact and network with adult volunteers from our local community!
